- Having provided many children with the opportunity to increase their levels of physical outdoor activity last year by running successful outdoor learning clubs, we are planning to undertake the second phase of the development of our 'Forest School' area. We are seeking advice on how to maximise the use of a small space and the PE lead will undertake official 'Forest School' training. Children will be able to work as a team, problem solve and gain key skills through a range of outdoor activities such as den building, outdoor crafting and fire making.
- We are up-skilling all teachers by providing them with crucial CPD in both dance and yoga. Every teacher will have the opportunity to work alongside dance and yoga specialists in order to plan for and deliver an effective, balanced curriculum.
- We are increasing the range of sporting opportunities offered to our children. Taking account of pupil voice through our School Council meetings, we are including opportunities for children to participate in swimming, football, zumba, outdoor learning, boxercise and cricket.
- We are investing in the purchasing of high quality physical activity equipment to be used throughout the school during PE lessons, lunch times, break-times and in the Early Years provision.
